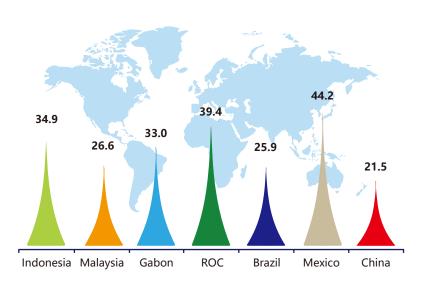






Overview of the GTI Index

In January 2023, the Global Timber Index (GTI) report shows that affected by New Year holiday and continuous rainy season, the GTI index of the timber producing countries like Indonesia, Malaysia, Gabon, ROC, Brazil, Mexico was all below the critical level (50%) this month, which represents that the prosperity of timber production and operation this month shrank from last month. The uncertainty in 2023 has brought great challenges for timber enterprises. ROC banned the export of logs from natural forests and plantation. The derailment of the trans-Gabon railway has affected timber transportation seriously. The decline in international market demand has affected every timber producing country.



The enterprises have feedback problems of the increased product inventory, lower sales price than cost, and long payment time for customers. China further optimized the prevention and control measures for the COVID-19, introduced a package of policies to "stabilize the economy". Tourism, film, catering and other services showed a significant rebound. However, a large number of employees returned home for the New Year holiday, and the production and operation activities of timber enterprises slowed down. Detailed data and analysis were shown in the GTI report of pilot countries.

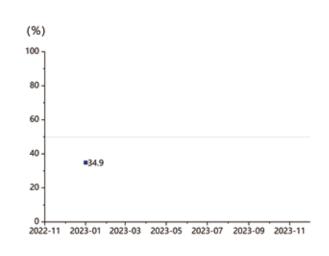

GTI-Indonesia Index in January 2023

On December 30, 2022, Indonesia cancelled all the other national measures for the prevention and control of COVID-19 epidemic except wearing masks indoors and in public transport. On the first workday in 2023, the President of Indonesia Joko Widodo expressed his hope that Indonesia would achieve more than 5% growth in 2023 when presiding over the opening ceremony of the country's stock exchange and inspecting the country's largest small commodity wholesale market. The minister of Coordinating Ministry for the Economy said that strong economic growth in 2022 would help it better cope with the challenges of a possible global recession in 2023. In 2022, Indonesia's economic growth achieved the best results in recent 10 years. According to the data released by Statistics Indonesia, GDP grew by 5.31% year-on-year in 2022, the highest growth rate since 2013 (5.56%), especially in the fourth quarter, which supported the annual economic growth.

In January 2023, Indonesia was in the rainy season, and the overcast and rainy weather slowed down the transportation of products. At the same time, due to the impact of rising fuel prices, falling log prices in the international

market and decreasing orders, the overall development of Indonesia's timber industry has slowed down, which has had an impact on the efficiency of enterprises. Enterprises hoped that the government will introduce incentive policies to revitalize the domestic and global wood products market. This month, the GTI-Indonesia Index registered 34.9%, was below the critical value (50%), indicating that the business prosperity of the superior timber enterprises represented by the GTI-Indonesia Index was declined from the previous month.

Challenges

- Rainy season affects business activities, lower log prices, fewer orders from buyers.
- Poor road conditions in rainy season hinder transportation efficiency, especially the long-distance transportation of wood and wood products.
- Sluggish global market for timber products, especially the Japanese market.
- Due to the downturn in the global wood processing market, the demand for wood processing exports has decreased and prices have fallen, which has impacted wood processing industry that provides raw materials.
- Adverse conditions in the global wood products market have led to lower orders and lower prices from buyers in Australia and New Zealand.
- The decline in foreign orders has led to a decline in the price of export wood products.
- The depressed plywood market and lower prices, which affects the log production.
- Fuel prices have risen sharply in a short period of time, and production costs have increased.

- The integrated industry has stopped or reduced production, which has had an impact on the operating efficiency of enterprises.
- There are operational and technical problems in the transportation of raw materials from the concession site to the factory.
- Long-term contracts for foreign plywood are not stable.
- Lack of raw materials for processing Merbau wood and long delays in delivery.
- The low market value of enterprises leads to a decline in production.

Suggestions

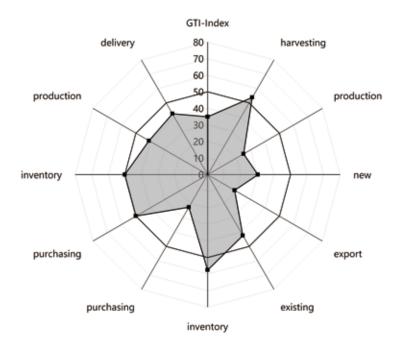
- Cooperate with the local government to improve the traffic road , in order to speed up the product transportation.
- Develop delivery plans for partners to adapt to weather conditions.
- Improve the global market for wood products and resume the import and export activities of wood products.
- Breakthrough policies are needed to revive the market for processed wood products at the domestic and global levels, as well as to promote and provide incentives for SFM and legality certified wood products.
- Evaluate vendors of transportation equipment, especially for transportation rental prices and plan to procure their own transportation equipment.
- Support and encourage the use of waste raw materials in natural forests to improve the efficiency of wood utilization.
- Develop diversified wood products and adjust business strategy according to the climate of the region.

• Restore the global market for wood products, stabilize fuel prices, and encourage the use of wood products with sustainable forest management certification and/or legality certification.



GTI-Indonesia sub-index

As for the GTI-Indonesia sub-index, in January 2023, harvesting index and inventory index of finished products were above the critical value (50%), purchasing prices index and inventory index of raw materials were equal to the critical value, while the remaining 7 sub-indexes were all below the critical value.

The harvesting index registered 53.8%, was above the critical value, indicating that the harvesting volume of the superior timber enterprises represented by the GTI-Indonesia was more than that of last month.

The production index registered 25.0%, was below the critical value, indicating that the production volume of the superior timber enterprises represented by the GTI-Indonesia was less than that of last month.

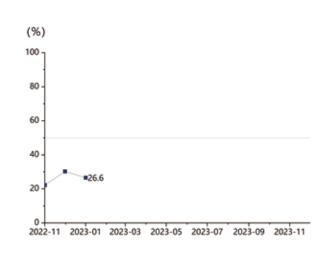


GTI-Malaysia Index in January 2023

In 2023, Malaysia will take boosting the economy as its top priority, focusing on green economy, digital economy and technological development, while vigorously developing tourism services and supporting the development of SMEs. The Prime Minister of Malaysia Datuk Seri Anwar said that special attention will be given to SMEs in 2023 budget. The Tourism, Arts and Culture Ministry (MOTAC) plans to attract 5 million Chinese tourists in 2023, which was 3.1 million in 2019. At the end of January, data released by Department of Statistics Malaysia Official Portal (DOSM) showed that Malaysia's total exports grew by about 25% in 2022, approaching 1.6 trillion Ringgit; The total import volume was close to 1.3 trillion Ringgit, breaking through the 1 trillion Ringgit mark for the first time. The development momentum of Malaysia's trade last year has laid a good foundation for the future.

In January 2023, Malaysia was still in the rainy season with frequent floods. As of January 27, more than 12000 people were reported to have been forced into flood relief centers in four regions. Affected by heavy rain, the cost of timber transportation has increased, the stock of logs has

gradually decreased, and the overall development of Malaysia's timber industry is still in a shrinking trend. At the same period, enterprises feedback problems such as insufficient orders and products, full warehouses at destination ports, and slowing demand. This month, the GTI-Malaysia Index registered 26.6%, a decrease of 3.7 percentage points from the previous month, was below the critical value (50%) for 3 consecutive months, indicating that the business prosperity of the superior timber enterprises represented by the GTI-Malaysia Index was declined from the previous month.

Challenges

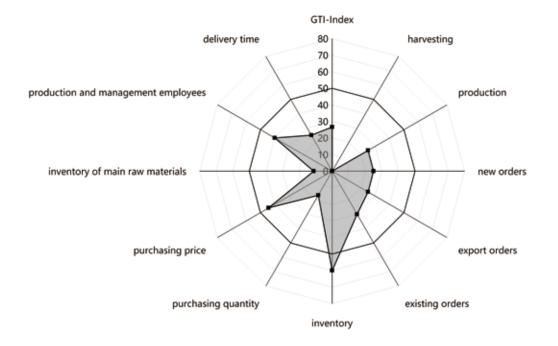
- Not enough labor & order.
- Shortage of workers and slow in demand.
- Shortage of order and volume, shipment decrease.
- Less export orders.
- Difficult to allocate shipment as the warehouse at the destination ports are fully occupied.
- Not enough of raw material.
- Rainy season causing low log stock.
- Increasing cost of raw material.

- Strict control on production cost.
- Wait for the passage a time.

- Increase harvesting of the plantation forest & improve yield of the plantation forest.

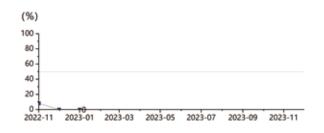

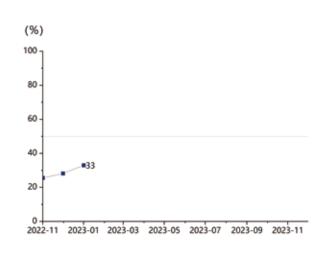


GTI-Gabon Index in January 2023

On January 9, 2023, Gabon issued a presidential decree appointing the Vice-President and the Prime Minister, the new Prime Minister announced the new government list. Murangi was appointed as the minister of the Ministry of Water and Forest. The new government will give priority to all efforts to improve the daily life of Canadians. In terms of infrastructure, 51 kilometers of the PK12-PK105 section of the first phase of the "Trans-Gabon Highway" project have been renovated, and the construction progress will be accelerated in 2023. On December 24 last year, the railway (Libreville-Franceville) derailed in PK333 sections (Overway-Bouvet) under the influence of heavy rains, which had a certain impact on industrial transportation.

Affected by rainy and holiday in January, the processing of Gabon' s timber factories was still in the contraction trend of off-season. The enterprises reported that the fuel price was high, the customer's payment time was too long, the export order was small, and there was a problem

of train derailment that had to extend the delivery time to the customer. This month, GTI-Gabon index registered 33.0%, an increase of 4.8 percentage points from the previous month, was below the critical value (50%) for three consecutive months, indicating that the business prosperity of the superior timber enterprises represented by the GTI-Gabon index was declined from the previous month.



Challenges

- Long payment period for customers.
- Not enough export orders.
- Holiday slowed down the production and caused higher fuel prices.
- Log supply, industrial diesel prices, and need drilling permit.
- Spare parts were rare on local market.
- Fuel cost slowed down the transport of products.
- Rainy season.
- Less business and problems in customs.
- No productions since Oct 2022 due to the holiday.
- Tree species such as Padouk, Acajou, Doussie have been newly listed in "the Convention on International Trade in Endangered Species of Wild Fauna and Flora".
- Tight cash flow.

• In December, after the landslide of the railway, the railway was closed, resulting in the suspension of logging work, delays in the transportation of natural gas and fuel, and technical layoffs in the logging team.

- Declining timber market.
- It rained heavily at about every other time.

• The cutting tax verified by the administrative department is not standardized and cannot be delivered.

Suggestions

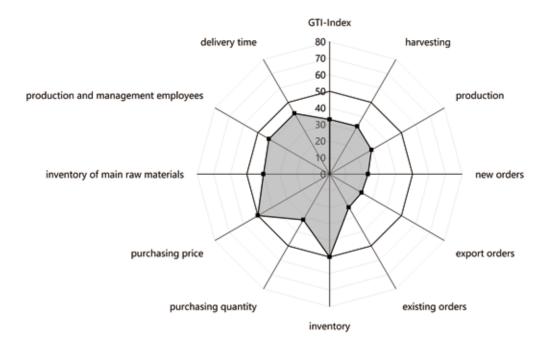
- Looking for more customers and markets. As a result of the derailment event, the log supply and delivery time may be delayed.
- Wait and adapt to market fluctuations.
- Obtain forestry license and reduce the price of industrial diesel.
- Review of fluctuations in emergency import procedures.
- Provide support to local custom resumed production through exploration.
- SETRAG: Prioritize the farthest distribution station, strengthen the forest product traction capacity of SETRAG, and develop an emergency product evacuation plan. Fuel: Reduce the manufacturer's tariff and increase the tariff to the same price as the public pump. State compensation to ease the burden on industrialists. SERTAG had to establish a timetable for the resumption of railway operations.
- Simplify the licensing process and provide convenience measures for CIETS-listed species, such as Padouk, Acajou, Doussie.

- Improve transportation infrastructure and complete supporting national policies to cope with rising costs.
- Enterprises may pay in advance even if in hard situation.
- Immediate repair of the railway line is a condition for effective resumption of activities.
- Maximize the operation of the economic park/zone in in peak season
- Lower fuel price.



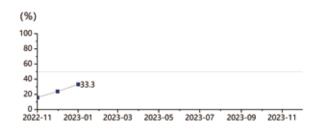

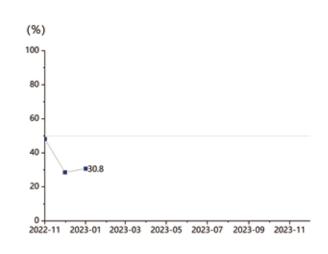


GTI-ROC Index in January 2023

In 2023, The Republic of Congo keeps promoting economic development by virtue of its natural resources. According to the joint report of the ROC government and the World Bank, the economic growth rate of ROC is expected to reach 3.7% in 2023, higher than 1.2% in 2022, benefiting from the growth of non-oil sectors. The World Bank recommends that ROC take four urgent measures: promoting agricultural development, improving labor productivity, establishing an warning system for diseases caused by climate change, and combating sea level rise in coastal areas. ROC banned the export of log in January, and its impacts on local timber industry still need further observation.

Affected by the rainy season, the timber production and operation activities in ROC continued to slow down in January 2023. The GTI-ROC enterprises feedbacked problems such as rising water level caused by rain, poor road conditions and mechanical failure have limited the production and operation of timber enterprises. The cost of local raw materials and transportation have also increased significantly, which has reduced the profit margin of enterprises.

Enterprise suggested that the local government may improve transportation conditions and provide supports in forest management and production equipment. This month, the GTI-ROC Index registered 30.8%, an increase of 2.2 percentage points from the previous month, was below the critical value for 3 consecutive months,, indicating that the business prosperity of the superior timber enterprises represented by the GTI-ROC index was declined from the previous month.

Challenges

- Poor road condition, difficulties in transportation.
- Rising water level during rainy season.
- Rainy season and the breakdown of machinery and equipment affected the production and operation activities.
- Short supply of diesel across the country, higher prices of raw materials and ocean freight rates.
- Lower market demand, higher cost of raw materials and transportation.
- The operation area was far away from the industrial site and the port, and the operation cost was increased.
- Administration institutions in different regions were not efficient.
- Production was shut down since October, with machines breaking down and lack of operation permits.
- The operation department was shut down.
- The current forest policy was not suitable for domestic sustainable forest management.

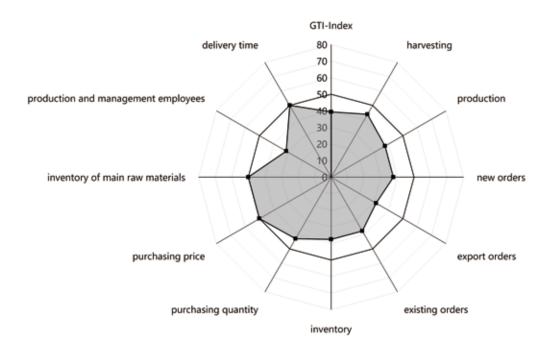
Suggestions

- More production equipment.
- The state relseases some policies to reduce transportation costs.
- The state gives some support for the forestry enterprises to maintain roads.
- Timber enterprises strengthen communication with relevant departments.
- Lower fuel prices.
- Enhance the reliability of forest concessions.
- Government coordinates forest management systems.



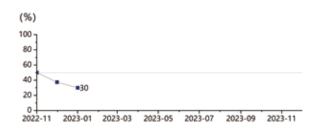

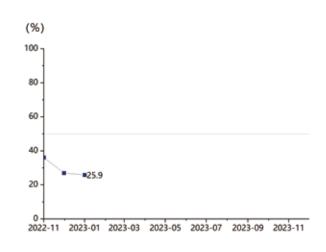
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GTI-Brazil Index in January 2023

On January 1, 2023, the new President of Brazil Lula was sworn in and stressed in his inaugural speech that the new government would work for "unity and reconstruction", solve the crises and challenges in Brazil, and promote Brazil to return to the world's major economies. The Brazilian government is actively looking for measures to revive the economy, such as seeking to sign an agreement between the Southern Common Market (MERCOSUR) and EU by mid-2023, which can not hinder the industrialization of the region. By the end of January, the leaders of Brazil and Argentina said they were studying the launch of a common South American currency. Brazil's import and export data for 2022 showed a good development trend this month. According to the data released by the Ministry of Development, Industry and Foreign Trade, Brazil's total exports in 2022 were \$335 billion, an increase of 19.3% over the previous year; The total import volume was \$272.7 billion, an increase of 24.3% over the previous year. Brazil's trade surplus rose to \$62.3 billion that year, was the highest value since 1989, and the rise in international commodity prices was the biggest factor driving the trade surplus in 2022.

In January 2023, affected by the domestic political turmoil, declining demand for timber industry,

holidays and rainy season, the production of Brazil' s timber industry continued to slow down, and enterprises reported problems such as unstable exchange rate, lower demand in Europe and North America, and lower sales prices than costs. Enterprises hope to reduce internal costs, look for new customers and strengthen product quality control. This month, the GTI-Brazil Index recorded 25.9%, a decrease of 1.1 percentage points from the previous month, was below the critical value for 3 consecutive months, indicating that the business prosperity of the superior timber enterprises represented by the GTI-Brazil Index shrank from the previous month.

Challenges

- Get prices that cover at least production costs.
- Vacation period, government and exchange rate instability.
- Product Quality
- Lack of demand in the domestic (internal) market. Export sales cost does not cover the cost of raw materials.
- Lack of demand to Europe and North America.
- The weather a lot of rain as we work directly in the forest, this has a direct impact on field operations.
- Shipping and Vacation Period.
- Reduction in wood processing orders.

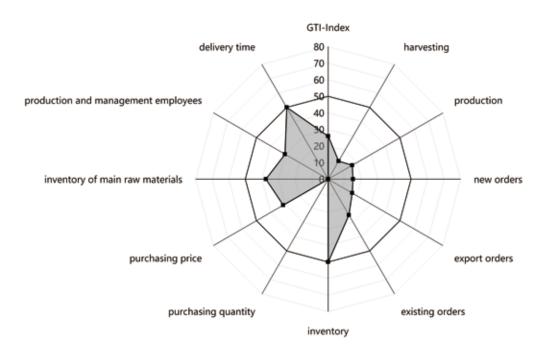
Suggestions

- The manager imagines that the market will regulate itself from February onwards. Many companies have closed their doors for not being able to produce and supply will drop dramatically in January and early February. Therefore, he believes that with this reduction it will be necessary to look for companies that have not left the market and that prices return to normality.
- Expect and seek internal cost reduction to become more competitive.
- Increased quality control, correcting failures as they happen.
- Schedule operations according to this climatic seasonality, as already done.
- Seek new customers and offer discounts that guarantee our production.



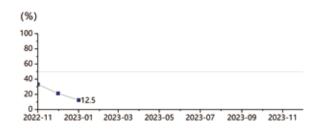

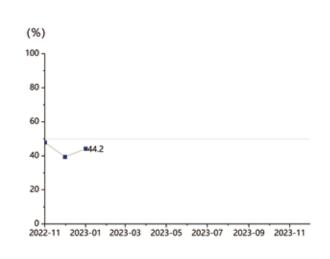


GTI-Mexico Index in January 2023

In 2023, Mexico's economic development has accelerated and continued to advance in attracting foreign investment and accelerating the development of manufacturing industry. On January 3, Mexico stated that it hoped to promote the unity and economic integration of all countries in the American continent, promote the common development of countries in the region, and solve the problems of development inequality and migration. Overall, Mexico's economy has continued to improve over the past two years. According to national statistics agency INEGI reported on Tuesday, Mexico's gross domestic product grew at a seasonally adjusted annual rate of 3 % in 2022, Mexico's manufacturing sector has outperformed agriculture and services throughout the year, registered as 3.2%. The agriculture and services sectors grew as 2.8% and 2.7%.

In January 2023, under the influence of unstable international market demand, government's regulation on timber industry, and bad weather condition, enterprises reported that production costs were gradually increasing, imported products had a greater impact on domestic commodities, and there was a backlog of raw

materials in warehouses. Mexican companies were looking to expand new markets to boost exports. Also, the enterprises feedback that the export audit process is cumbersome and takes too much time, hoping that the relevant departments can optimize the export process and release the stimulus policies. This month, the GTI-Mexico Index registered 44.2%, an increase of 4.8 percentage points from the previous month, and was below the critical value (50%) for 3 consecutive months, indicating that the business prosperity of the superior timber enterprises represented by the GTI-Mexico Index was declined from the previous month.



Challenges

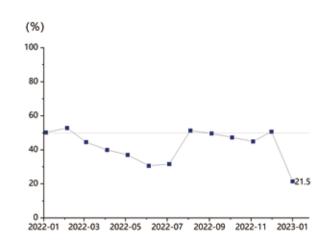


GTI-China Index in January 2023

In January 2023, with the extensive implementation of optimization measures for COVID-19 in China, and the release of many economic- stabilization policies, the domestic demand is rapidly increasing in the short term, the economy is steadily recovering in the new year. In late January, a large number of employees returned home to celebrate the Chinese New Year, and the utilization of capacity of manufacturing enterprises was affected to a certain extent. However, tourism, film, catering and other service industries have shown a marked recovery. During the Chinese New Year holidays, 308 million domestic tourists traveled and the box office of movies exceeded 6.7 billion RMB. indicating that China's economy has showed steadily rebounded and the positive trend.

The development of China's timber manufacturing industry in January showed significant off-season characteristics due to the New Year. Compared with the previous month, the number of workers in enterprises and factories

was decreased significantly, and the number of production volume and orders was declined significantly too. This month, the GTI-China Index registered 21.5%, a decrease of 29.2 percentage points from the previous month, fell below the critical value (50%), indicating that the business prosperity of the superior timber enterprises represented by the GTI-China Index was declined from the previous month.

Survey methodology

The Global Timber Index (hereinafter referred to as GTI) is compiled based on the a survey of leading timber enterprises from the main timber producing and consuming countries. The questionnaire is disseminated to the timber enterprises monthly and the Secretariat of Global Green Supply Chain Initiative (hereinafter referred to as GGSC) organizes the experts to calculate and compile the GTI report, based on statistical analysis of the collected data and information.

With the support of the International Tropical Timber Organization (hereinafter referred to as ITTO), GGSC has set up focal points in the pilot countries from the timber producing and consuming countries. In the initial phase (2022), the GTI plaform will cover seven pilot countries: Indonesia, Malaysia , Gabon, Republic of Congo, Brazil, Mexico, and China. The questionnaires will be completed and collected by these focal points from 25th to 30th every month. The GTI reports will be regularly released to stakeholders of global forest products industry.

Based on the characteristics of the timber and timber products industry in different countries, the current GTI questionnaire is divided into two categories: the timber producer and the timber manufacturer. For the timber producing countries, the focus is the investigation on the development trend of local timber harvesting and supply, covering logs, sawn timber, plywood, etc. For the timber consuming countries (such as China), the focus is the investigation on the prosperity and development trend of local timber processing and manufacturing industry, covering wooden floor, doors and furniture, etc.

Data and Interpretation

GTI index contains diffusion index and comprehensive index.

(1)

The calculation of GTI diffusion index. GTI has 11 diffusion index (or called sub-indices) based on the data from 11 objective questions which covers production (or harvesting), new orders, new export orders, existing orders, inventory of products, purchasing quantity or import, purchasing prices of main raw materials, inventory of raw material, employees, and delivery time. The diffusion index is calculated by adding the percentage of enterprises with positive answers to half of the percentage with unchanged answers.

The calculation of GTI comprehensive index. GTI comprehensive index(GTI index for short) is calculated based on the diffusion indexes of five of the indexes with different weights: production , new orders, inventory of raw material, employees, delivery time. The five diffusion indexes and their weights are determined according to their leading influence on the industrial economy.

The value of the index is between 0-100%, and 50% is the critical value of the index. A GTI index reading above 50 percent indicates that the industry prosperity is generally expanding; below 50 percent indicates that it is generally declining.
